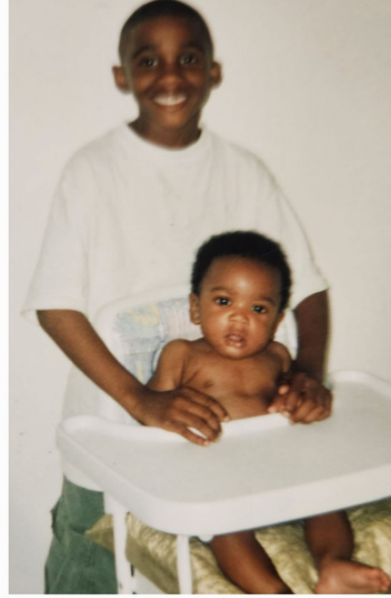
# OBITUARY
