# OBITUARY

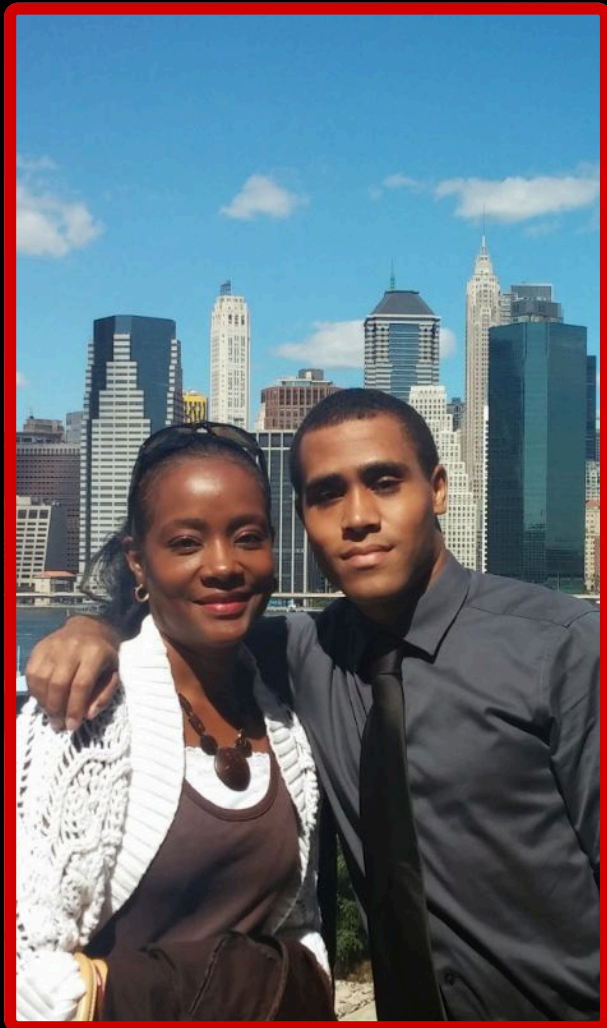
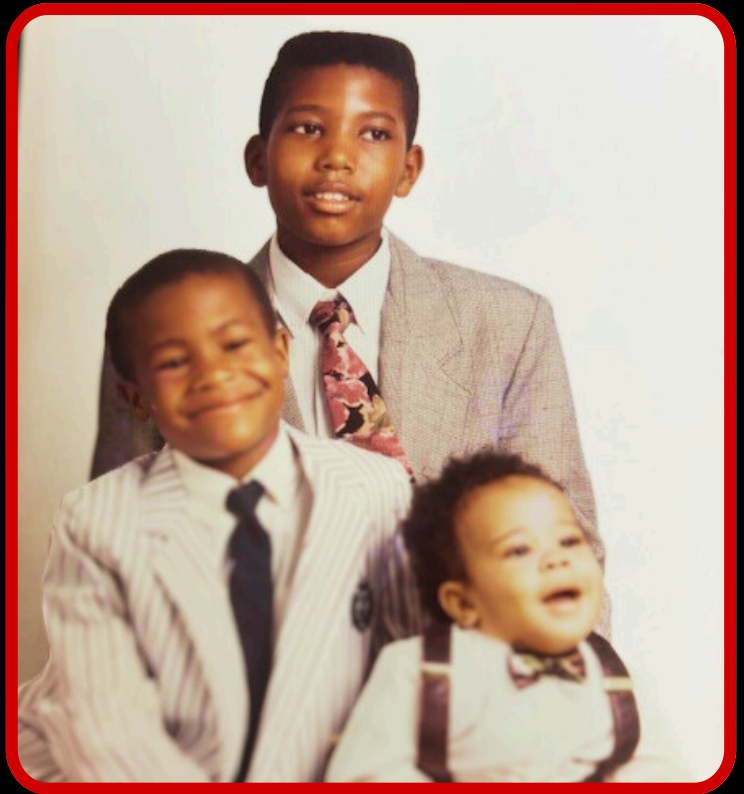
