I do not sleep.*

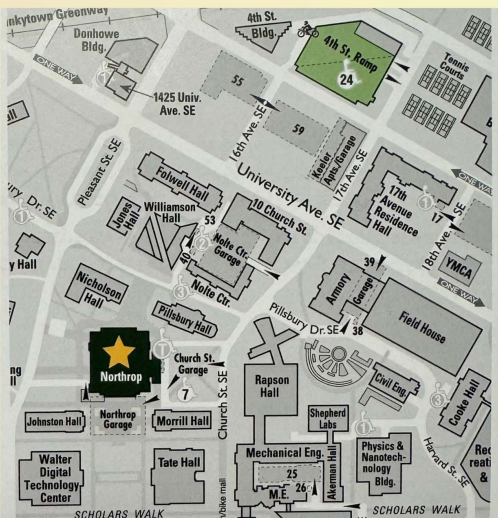
*I am a thousand winds that blow.
