# In Remembrance

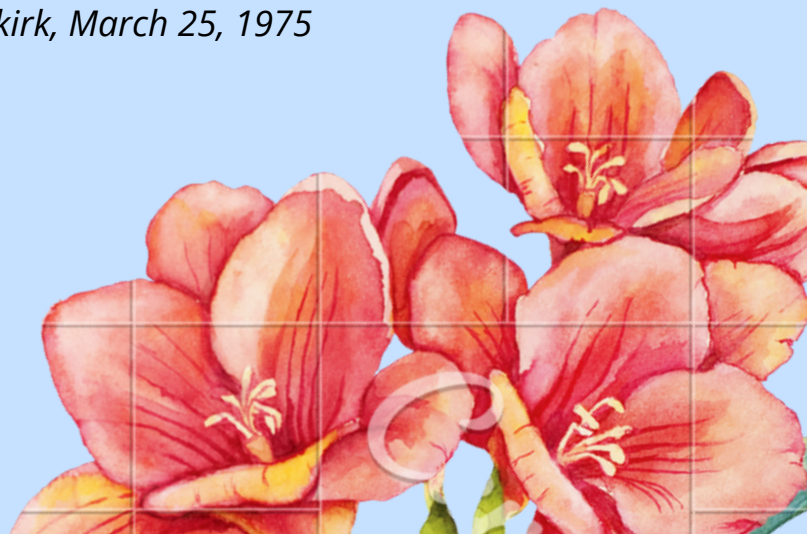
The voice of our loved one
