Reflections of Life

Thompson G. Lee "TG" was born on February 26th 1931 in Old Harbour Bay, St. Catherine Jamaica. He worked for Alcan Port Esquivel for 27 years and was a supervisor of the port facilities. A well-known businessman in the Old Harbour area, he and his wife Alice owned and operated a wholesale business Fook Hing & Co. for over 20 years before retiring to Miami Florida to be closer to their children and grandchildren. He is preceded in death by his wife Alice and is survived by his children Raymond (Peta), Andy (Marita), Jeffrey, Alicia (Dennis) and Suzette (Matthew). Grandchildren Melissa (Alistair), Ryan, Kayla, Genesh (Su), Deniella, Alec, Julian, and Sage. Great grandchild Arianna and baby Alistair, and sister Joyce Chung.

Thompson (and Alice) lived in Colbeck, Old Harbour surrounded by the sweetest mango and fruit trees. He designed and built both homes on Bowers Drive. Both were very active in the community and were instrumental in the building of the new Sacred Heart Catholic Church and preparatory school.

Thompson looked forward to bird shooting every year in remote areas of Jamaica with his friends and his two sons. He was a marksman and brought home many birds for Alice to pluck and cook. He was a master planner and loved to construct houses, storerooms, car ports and any building projects for which he would develop detailed materials list, cost and sketches. His building designs were the most secure you could find with burglar bars, iron grill gates, triple locks and solid wood doors. Ackee & saltfish, fried dumpling, bami, oxtail, curry goat, fry fish (sprat), roast beef, chicken foot, pig foot, pear, coconut water, mangoes, pineapple, papaya were just some of his favorite Jamaican foods.

He retired to Miami and adapted to the American culture and was an avid basketball fan, his favorite player being Steph Curry. If you ever wanted the score of last night's game, or to know who got traded, or which team is going to win the NBA championship, just call him.
