

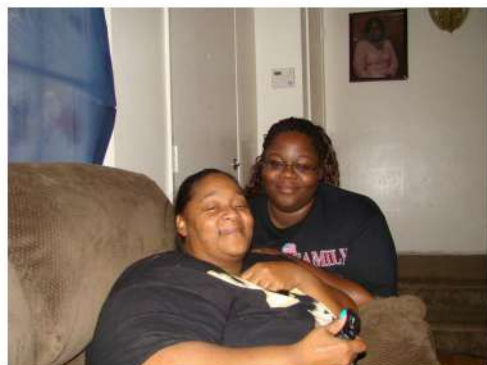
## New Testament
