Obituary

Randall Stuart "Randy" Markham of Deer Park, TX passed away on July 30, 2023 at Pasadena, TX surrounded by his wife Nancy, daughter Brandi, and granddaughter Samantha.

Randall was born to John and Anna Fae Markham on July 10, 1952 in Trinity, TX. Randy had two older brothers John and Jeff Markham, Randy was the baby of the family and was often raised as the only child in the house.

Randall was a man of many talents, as a young boy Randy played baseball as well as participating in football and track in high school. His record as the fastest sprinter at Deer Park High School still stands, a symbol of his hard work and dedication. After graduating high school in 1971, he attended Blinn College where he fell in love with the area and often enjoyed floating the river. Randall married the love of his life Nancy in 1975 and welcomed their daughter Brandi into the world in 1976. Soon after that Randy landed a job as a Chemical Operator ultimately becoming his career.
