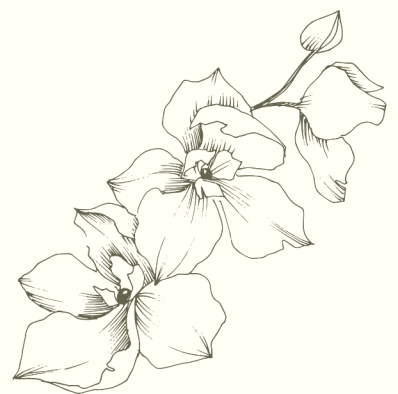

The family is grateful to Hosea Bilyeu for his service to his Sister in Christ by leading our Memorial today.

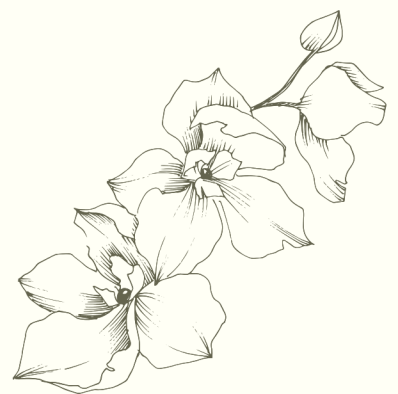
