I would not hurt so much.*

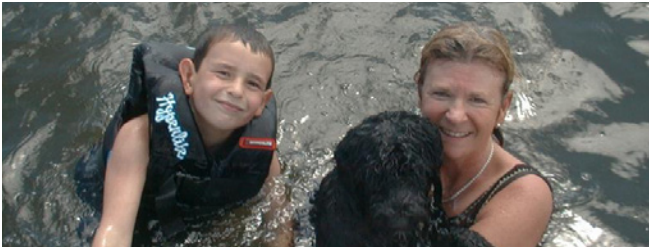
*But goodness knows I would not
