## OBITUARY

Camilla Andrea Burnett, affectionately known as Cammie, Cam, and lovingly called KK by her niece, was born on July 7, 1963, in Greensboro, North Carolina, to the late Melvin Evans Burnett Sr. and the late Mindell Davis Burnett. A radiant soul, Camilla left a lasting impression on everyone she encountered with her warmth, compassion, and unwavering presence.

Camilla was educated in the Guilford County School System, attending Peeler and Blueford Elementary, Lincoln Junior High, and graduated from James B. Dudley High School in 1981. She pursued further education at the University of North Carolina at Greensboro and earned a vocational certificate from the Wilma Boyd School of Career and Travel Training in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. She worked at American Express for many years until health challenges led her to new paths of service. She later became director of Jack in the Box Daycare, where she was cherished by children and families alike.

A woman of deep faith, Camilla was an active and devoted member of Mount Zion United Church of God. Over the years, she served in numerous ministries and roles, including the Sunshine Band, Junior and Crusade Choirs, Sunday School secretary, children's church and VBS teacher, singles and connections groups, Big Friends/Little Friends mentor, Adopt-a-Senior sponsor, and the finance committee. She was known to pray, uplift, and encourage others—often crossing the sanctuary without her walker just to hug or anoint someone in need.

Camilla had a creative soul. She loved arts and crafts, spontaneous adventures, and meaningful conversations. She found joy in simple moments—laughing with family, listening with care, and celebrating others with her vibrant spirit. She had a gift for turning ordinary moments into treasured memories.

She is lovingly remembered by her sisters, Jean Burnett West and Carla Holley; brother-in-law, Marcus Holley; brother, Melvin Burnett; and sister-in-law, Avis Burnett. Her beloved niece and nephew, Caila Holley and Malachi Burnett, held a special place in her heart, along with her “pupphew,” Shinobu Holley, who brought her endless joy.

Camilla also leaves behind two cherished aunts, Josie Gross of Brooklyn, NY, and Vivian Davis of NC; a dear friend, Herbert; and a host of cousins and close friends. She was a second mother, aunt, and godmother to many—Ashley Moore, Sherelle Dawson, Ariell McIver, and numerous others who lovingly claimed her as family. She became “Aunt KK” not only to her daycare families but also to many of Caila's friends.

Camilla knew no strangers. Her relationships often blossomed into lasting bonds, even with her doctors and caregivers. She was a confidant, encourager, and a steady light in the lives of many.
