Clinton "Tommy" Cooke 88, of Paterson New Jersey, passed away on January 15, 2023, after a long battle with cancer.

Tommy was born on July 7, 1934, to father Kenneth Cooke and mother Constance Lazarus in Somerton, St. James, Jamaica, West Indies.
