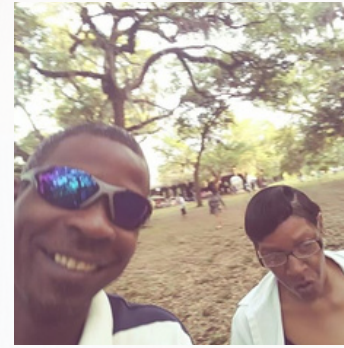

All filled with tears for me;

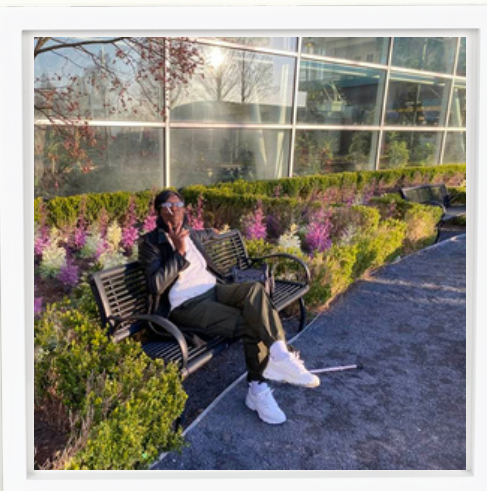
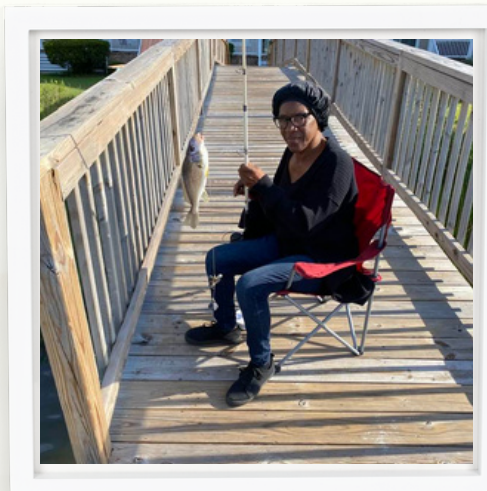
I wish so much you wouldn't cry

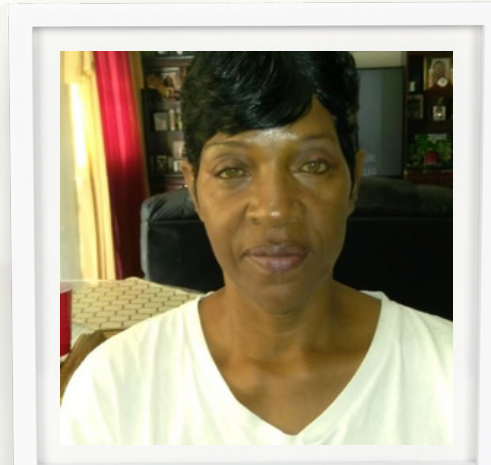
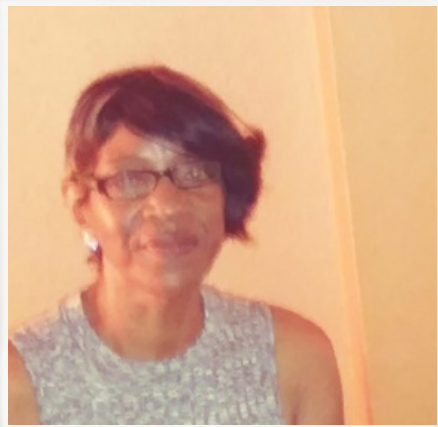
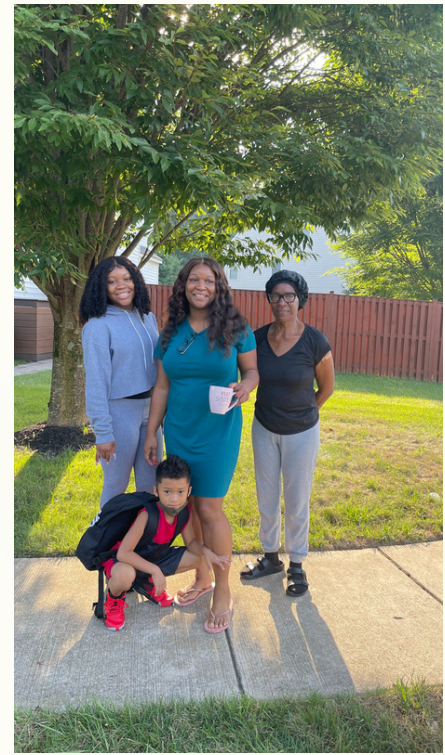
