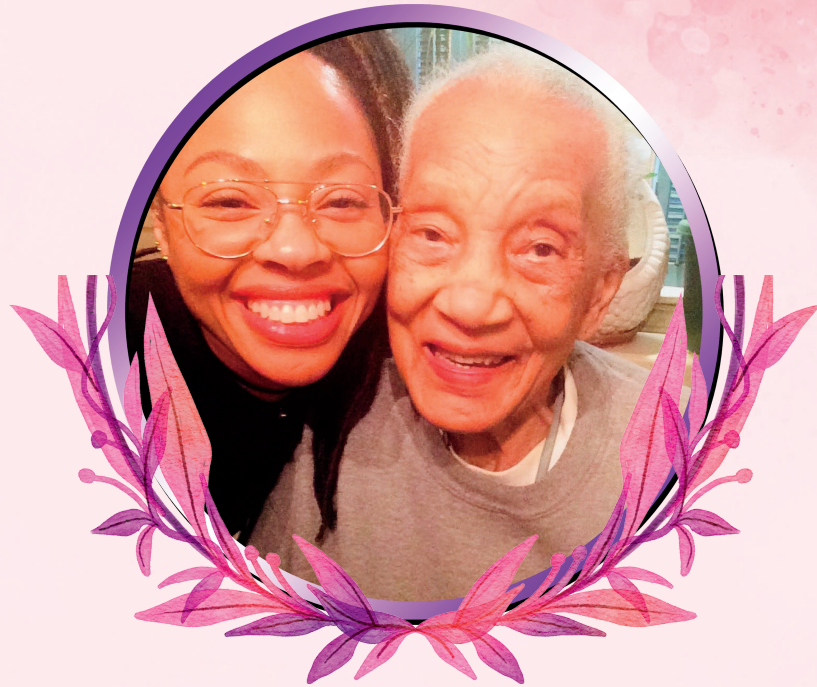
Grandmother,
